- The General Carrying con note number must be supplied on all CHP and Loscam dockets.
- Transfers appearing on the CHP/Loscam accounts of General Carrying in excess of 60 days will automatically have a new effective date, being the CHP/Loscam close off date of the current invoice.
- A signed CHP/Loscam transfer docket is the *only* Proof of Delivery accepted by General Carrying.
- General Carrying will not accept any responsibility or liability for pallet transaction/rejection enquiries after 180 days from the transfer date and will not be investigated.

To ensure these transfers are accepted onto the General Carrying's pallet accounts it is the responsibility of the sending customer to follow these procedures. Failure to do so may result in the cancellation of the Transfer Docket and a claim will need to be submitted to Pallet Control Australia to have these reinstated at the current date.
